

# Final project presentations, ASL, Spring 2020

Info for students

## Final presentations: Time and General Info

They take place (roughly) during our regular slot Monday 10-12, Wednesday 13-15. We start at full hour this time. We give a 30 minute slot to each team. So valid slots are

Monday: 10:00, 10:30, 11:00, 11:30, 12:00

Wednesday: 13:00, 13:30, 14:00, 14:30, 15:00

Time slots and presenter are drawn randomly (trust us, it is random; see time line below)

Presentation time: 12 minutes, rest Q&A

Presenter should try to answer but can delegate (or others can add to the answer).

The project should essentially done by presentation time. It is ok if you still want to do the one or other experiment or complete smaller parts. It is not ok, if major parts are future work (e.g., we did not try SIMD yet, plan to do next).

All team members have to attend and be ready to answer questions.

## Presentation

Format: Powerpoint or pdf.

Part on explaining the algorithm should be relatively short, focus is on optimizations and analyses (see project system).

Make sure you have good plots including of course performance plots.

## Timeline

**Anytime:** make sure you will have a good internet connection and setup for the presentation.

**Saturday end of day:** submit presentation to advisor(s)

**Saturday end of day:** update information in project system (as usual, be very brief)
